Dear Parents

I hope sincerely that you have had a wonderful summer and that you and your child are looking forward to returning to school on Tuesday 5th September. A reminder that students must be in school by 8:40am on that day.

I am writing to reassure and remind all parents of our ongoing commitment to the highest standards in all respects immediately on our return to school, and would ask parents to support our expectations around uniform in the 1st instance. Below is a summary of our uniform requirements and we will insist that these standards are maintained at all times; your support in ensuring your child is properly attired for school is also appreciated.

Boys

- Plain white shirt, long or short sleeves, with collar
- School tie
- Black trousers with/without turnups
- Navy blue blazer with school badge
- Plain dark socks
- Plain black low cut shoes; not trainers or boots
- Navy blue V neck sweater (optional)

Girls

- White blouse, long or short sleeves, with collar
- School tie
- Plain navy knee length 'A' line skirt or navy, knee-length, square fronted, pleated pinafore dress with straps over the shoulder
- Plain navy/black trousers
- Navy blue blazer with school badge
- Plain white socks, plain navy ribbed tights, plain knee high navy socks
- Plain black shoes with low heels (no boots)
- Navy blue cardigan (optional)

Blazers must be worn at all times

Outer garments:

Permitted: Dark coloured anoraks or coats (no leather or denim)

Not permitted in school: Tracksuit tops or hoodies

Guidance on acceptable footwear has been sent home previously and is available on the school website.
